#### **School Counsellor's Update**

Our school counsellor Julia Kwiet-Lipari has been busy this term and her hours have been increased to 3 full days this year. Julia is available for school based counselling and family support on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesdays. Families can contact her directly on her mobile 0457 359 338 with any questions or concerns. Face to face meetings can be arranged on site.

It has been a difficult time for many families and our community with ongoing stressors from COVID, the impact of home schooling and uncertain times. Approximately 1 in 5 young people experience significant anxiety and fearfulness that affects their daily life. The NSW Department of Education has engaged the Centre for Emotional Health at Macquarie University to offer free access to online treatments for school students who have significant anxiety disorders. The "Cool Kids Program" can be accessed online and our school counsellor plans to start running groups and information sessions for parents later this year.

Regular attendance at school is critical to ensuring that every student has the kind of opportunities in life that he or she deserves. Non-attendance has a variety of effects on students, both academically and socially.

If your child is absent due to illness, please inform the school by contacting our school office and explain absences for the day by entering in the COMPASS Parent Portal. Alternatively you can send us an email or call our school office on 8869 6000.

Please note if you enter your child absent days via COMPASS Parent Portal, the <u>time</u> is not to be adjusted.

If your child is unwell due to COVID you must notify the school office immediately.

When a student is away for more than two days, a Medical Certificate will be required when returning to school.

### **Office News**

Notification of Student Leaving	Leave of Absence

The Diocesan Tuition Fee and School Building Levy are annual fees billed in Terms 1, 2 and 3. A pro rata fee based on weeks enrolled for the year is made for students entering the School part way during a term. If a student leaves the School during a term, no refund will be made in respect of the remaining portion of that term. Other School Based Fees for items such as camps, excursions, materials or technology may be charged to a student's account and are payable under the same conditions as Diocesan Fees. A Term's notice in writing must be given to the School Principal before the withdrawal of a student or a full term's fees will be payable. If your child is going on extended leave greater than 5 days, an **Application for Exemption Form** must be completed and returned to the office prior to the leave date. Please complete the following form <u>Application Extended Leave</u>. This leave will be considered by the Principal for approval.

Please note that any Leave time taken during term will impact on your child's learning. Our Diocesan mantra is, 'Every Child, Every Day' and students are legally obliged to attend school every day of the school year. Holidays and Leave should ideally be taken in school holiday periods.
