Luke 12:35-40 A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke

See that you are prepared

Jesus said to his disciples: 'See that you are dressed for action and have your lamps lit. Be like men waiting for their master to return from the wedding feast, ready to open the door as soon as he comes and knocks. Happy those servants whom the master finds awake when he comes. To celebrate and expose the children to quality literature, we will be opening the library for a Book Fair. Parents are invited to come along to our Book Character Parades which will take place in two sessions: 12:30-1:15 for the primary grades and 2:00-2:45 for the infants grades. Alternatively, students can come dressed according to the theme of Book Week this year '*Dreaming with eyes open.*'

Notification of Student Leaving

Leave of Absence

The Diocesan Tuition Fee and School Building Levy are annual fees billed in Terms 1, 2 and 3. A pro rata fee based on weeks enrolled for the year is made for students entering the School part way during a term. If a student leaves the School during a term, no refund will be made in respect of the remaining portion of that term. Other School Based Fees for items such as camps, excursions, materials or technology may be charged to a student's account and are payable under the same conditions as Diocesan Fees. A Term's notice in writing must be given to the School Principal before the withdrawal of a student or a full term's fees will be payable.

If your child is going on extended leave greater than 5 days, an Application for Exemption Form must be completed and returned to the office prior to the leave date. Please complete the following form Application Extended Leave. This leave will be considered by the Principal for approval.

Please note that any Leave time taken during term will impact on your child's learning. Our Diocesan mantra is, 'Every Child, Every Day' and students are legally obliged to attend school every day of the school year. Holidays and Leave should ideally be taken in school holiday periods.
